

Helping Local Farmers Grow

We are thrilled to share that over the past **8 years** we have awarded over **\$1 Million** to support for **474 farm capital improvement projects**. Thanks to our community funding team led by Big Y and the Harold Grinspoon Charitable Foundation, the Local Farmer Awards help fund projects related to growing, harvesting, and processing. Here are a few examples of this year's projects:

A farm in Dalton, MA purchased **enclosed and uniform containers** which will ensure the safe handling of pre-washed vegetables during storage and transportation. They also allow vegetables to be harvested at their peak ripeness and stored for soonest available retail or wholesale sales.

Improving soil health is the goal of many local farms. A farm in Deerfield, MA purchased a **flail mower** as part of an overall no-till strategy for soil health. The mower will reduce tractor passes through the field from an average of 10 per crop cycle down to 3. In addition to improving the soil health, they expect to see huge efficiencies in fuel and labor savings.

Shade for outdoor shitake mushrooms was the goal for a farm in Hatfield, MA. A high tunnel hoop house with high-quality shade cloth will allow them to protect the mushrooms in winter as they continue to expand their in-demand shitake mushroom business.

We admire our local farmers and thank them for all they do to feed us and care for the land. Our goal is to continue to help them grow.






