

Helping Local Farmers Grow

We are delighted to have three lead partners (Harold Grinspoon Charitable Foundation, Big Y, and the Massachusetts Society for Promoting Agriculture) along with a team of twelve other community funders in this, our 9th year. With this robust support, we have helped fund 97 infrastructure projects related to planting, growing, harvesting, and processing such as these three examples:

Purchase of a three bay sink & salad spinner for a farm in Deerfield to increase production and keep up with the retail and wholesale demand for fresh lettuce and other vegetables. The wash station will ensure the farm's adherence to food safety guidelines for farm store sales.

Construction of swine shelters for a farm in Brimfield to safeguard and pasture 16 pigs at a time, thereby diversifying meat options to include pork. The expansion will help speed up production and "turn time," which is only 6 months for pork compared to 2+ years for beef.

Purchase of a kult finger weeder/next generation cultivator for a farm in Great Barrington to better weed inside the plant rows. Reducing the need for hand weeding will help reduce labor costs by 20% and make the weeding process easier and more efficient. Effective cultivation is one key to the farm's success.

Clearly, the Local Farmer Awards are having an impact as **more than 260 local farms have received awards to date**. As the need for capital improvements continues to escalate, we remain firmly dedicated to the goal of **helping local farmers grow**.


