

The Local Farmer Awards provide grants of up to \$2,500 for capital improvements to farmers in Hampden, Hampshire, Franklin, and Berkshire Counties.



Since 2015, the Local Farmer Awards have

- Provided a unique funding program for Western Massachusetts farmers
- Invested over \$1.5 million to help local farms grow
- Supported 672 capital-improvement projects on 306 local farms

Our 2024 Sponsors

- Donors include three major partners along with 15 businesses and individual sponsors
- Contributed \$231,000 by providing grants to local farms
- Funded projects that helped farmers purchase needed equipment related to planting, growing, harvesting, and processing. (Such as tractor implements, irrigation improvements, livestock equipment, and building structures to extend the growing season.)
